

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

DIOCESE OF NEW ENGLAND, ORTHODOX CHURCH IN AMERICA

The Diocese of New England makes available limited scholarships for modest financial assistance according to the following guidelines:

A scholarship applicant must:

- 1) Be a parishioner of a member parish of the Diocese of New England, Orthodox Church in America;
- 2) Be currently enrolled, as a **full-time** or **part-time** student, in a degree granting program at an accredited Orthodox seminary with the knowledge and blessing of the diocesan bishop.

Students must re-apply each semester for which they seek scholarship assistance. Applications must be received by October 15th for the fall semester, and by February 28th for the spring semester.

All monies will be sent directly to the appropriate seminary office for tuition credit.

Scholarship assistance is given, according to a fixed amount established by the Diocesan Council. While assistance is given with 'no strings attached', it is hoped that scholarship recipients will consider working within the Diocese of New England upon completion of seminary studies.
